The envelope shall state "SEALED PROPOSAL – TOWNSEND ESTATES STREET RECLAMATION PROJECT" to prevent accidental opening. Any Proposal received after this time will not be considered. The Proposals will be publicly opened and read at 2:05 p.m. Tuesday, July 13, 2010 at the Catoosa County Government Building, 800 LaFayette Street, Ringgold, Georgia.

A 5% Bid Bond and P & P Bonds are required. Contractor must have minimum Worker's Comp and General Liability Insurance in full force and effect. No proposal will be considered unless it is accompanied by satisfactory evidence that the Bidder holds Georgia State Contractor's License of proper classification and in full force and effect, in compliance with the provisions of O.C.G.A. Sec. 43-41-2 et seq. Catoosa County reserves the right to accept or reject any and all proposals, to waive formalities, technicalities or irregularities and to re-advertise if necessary.
