Pursuant to O.C.G.A. 21-2-9 (c), notice is hereby given that the City of Ringgold shall hold a General Election on Tuesday, November 7, 2023, for the purpose of electing the Mayor and three (3) Council Members.

All City of Ringgold residents who are not registered to vote and who desire to register to vote in the General Election may register to vote through the close of business on Tuesday, October 10, 2023.

Early Voting will be held for 3 weeks located at the Freedom Center, 5238 Evitt St. Ringgold, GA 30736.

Week 1- Monday, October 16, 2023, through Friday, October 20, 2023: Hours are open daily 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Week 2- Monday, October 23, 2023, through Friday, October 27, 2023: Hours are open daily 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Week 3- Monday, October 30, 2023, through Friday, November 3, 2023: Hours are open daily 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

*Saturday Voting Dates and Times: Oct. 21, 2023, & Oct. 28, 2023. Hours- 9:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m.

*Extended hours on Thursday, November 2, 2023, 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Polls will be open on Election Day from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the Freedom Center, 5238 Evitt St. Ringgold, GA 30736.

The earliest day to apply for an absentee by mail ballot is Aug. 21, 2023. The last day to apply is Oct. 27, 2023.

Should a Runoff Election be required, such Runoff will be held on December 5, 2023.
