# PRESENTATION BY THE UNIVERSITY OF GEORGIA'S CARL VINSON INSTITUTE OF GOVERNMENT

Representatives from the University of Georgia's Carl Vinson Institute of Government (CVIOG) gave a presentation regarding the opportunity for reimagined development on the property located at 100 Gross Crescent Circle. CVIOG Representatives presented their preliminary data from the beginning stages of the Market Study and received guidance from the Board regarding next steps and further investigation into the possibilities for the Hospital building and it's adjoining property.

#### PAYMENT OF INVOICES RELATED TO HOSPITAL PROPERTY

Public Facilities Authority Clerk Meghan Trusley presented four utility invoices from North Georgia EMC and one utility invoice from Fireside Natural Gas related to the operation of the hospital property located at 100 Gross Crescent Circle in Fort Oglethorpe for ratification.

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The NGEMC invoices from October 2022, December 2022, January 2023, and February 2023 totaled \$200,962.49. The Fireside Natural Gas invoice from December 2022 totaled \$19,579.46. Ronnie Davis made a motion to approve the NGEMC invoices for an amount of \$200,962.49 and the Fireside Natural Gas invoice for an amount of \$19,579.46. Vice Chairman Long second the motion. Chairman Harris called for all those in favor of approving the motion to indicate so by saying aye. The motion passed 5-0 with no opposition.

#### PROPOSED APPROVAL OF REQUEST FOR PROPERTY TO BE DECLARED SURPLUS

#### PROPOSED APPROVAL OF AGREEMENT WITH T.E. TOWNSEND ENGINEERING

County Manager Dan Wright presented a proposed agreement between the Catoosa County Public Facilities Authority and T.E. Townsend Engineering for Mechanical and Electrical Engineering Design Feed for the Chiller Replacements for the Catoosa County Hospital – TVA EnergyRight Program. This agreement includes two phases. Phase 1 includes assistance in the completion of application documentation for funding by the TVA EnergyRight Program for a total of \$5,000. Phase 2 includes the development of design documents for the replacement of the existing 500 ton and 720 ton chillers with a high efficiency 500 ton water cooled chiller and a 100 ton heat recovery unit for a total of \$20,000. *Larry Black made a motion to approve the Agreement between the Catoosa County Public Facilities Authority and T.E. Townsend Engineering. Derek Rogers second the motion. Chairman Harris called for all those in favor of approving the motion to indicate so by saying aye. The motion passed 5-0 with no opposition.*
